Purpose:	To determine the future of the LEA pool and arrangements for school swimming in Hereford. To consider the longer term requirements for swimming across the whole county.
Decision:	<ul> <li>THAT:</li> <li>(i) the LEA pool remain permanently closed and disposal of the site be considered as part of the Council's property strategy;</li> <li>(ii) HALO continue to work closely with schools to deliver safe, cost effective, quality assured swimming provision that will enable support achievements of curriculum targets; and</li> <li>(iii) the Council, in partnership with HALO, develop a long term strategy to support the development of swimming provision across the county.</li> </ul>
Reasons for the Decision:	There is no viable business case or funding provision to support the re-opening of the LEA pool. To ensure the ongoing viability of existing public swimming facilities in the council, including access for schools provision, a longer term strategy for development will be needed.
Options Considered:	To reopen the LEA pool would be unsustainable in revenue terms and would require significant capital investment.
