Reasons for the Decision:	To redefine the policy to allow for greater flexibility in proposing the scope and criteria for residential permits schemes.
Options Considered:	To not approve the policy for implementation at this stage and the current agreed position remains in place. The current position, as outlined in this report, restricts the scope of proposing residential parking schemes to a localised area. The proposed changes allow for new schemes to extend past the localised area, if necessary, to help ensure parking issues are not moved from one area to another.
