Decision	 That: a) the proposed list of charges (at appendix 1) for services offered by the library service be approved and implemented from 9th October 2017; b) an amnesty on overdue charges across Herefordshire Libraries runs during National Libraries Week (week of 9th October 2017); c) charges be reviewed annually and where appropriate increased in line with inflation with delegated authority to the Library Services Manager.
