Purpose	To consider consultation feedback and confirm next steps of delivery of the South Wye Transport Package (SWTP) Active Travel Measures (ATM).
Decision	That: (a) having regard to the public support for the SWTP active travel proposals the assistant director environment and place be authorised to take all operational decisions necessary to progress further analysis and detailed design, to a maximum value of £500,000, to confirm a preferred package of active travel measures to be delivered with the SLR for approval by the cabinet member for infrastructure; (b) a programme for delivery of this preferred package of active travel measures and a procurement strategy for their delivery be developed for approval by the cabinet member for infrastructure.

Options considered	Not to progress further analysis of active travel measures, but this is not recommended as the objectives of the SWTP would not be met.
