Purpose	To approve a 6 week public consultation for the draft Minerals and Waste Local Plan. The Minerals and Waste Local Plan (MWLP) is an element of the Herefordshire Local Plan. It will align with the principles and strategic direction established in the Core Strategy, providing the council's preferred strategy and planning policy framework for meeting the county's minerals and waste management needs up to 2031 and beyond.
