The future waste collection arrangements will have a significant implication on future waste disposal arrangements. | | | | |
| | 2. Not to undertake a public consultation – This option has been discounted as public acceptance is essential to the successful delivery of future services. The public consultation will also support the development and roll out of the future service as it will help to consider the different practical implications and approaches to each service option for different housing types, such as flats and communal developments. | | | | |
