	c) authority be delegated to the Assistant Director for Regulation, Environment and Waste, following consultation with the Cabinet Member Infrastructure and Transport, to make any minor technical, textual or graphical amendments required to the draft MWLP and supporting documents, after the pre-submission consultation and prior to approval being sought from Council for submission of the MWLP to the Secretary of State for independent examination.

Options considered	1. Not to progress the MWLP would leave the council in a position where the extant Unitary Development Plan policies are out of date. This would be contrary to the recommendation of the Core Strategy's inspector, who stated that a separate MWLP should be prepared in accordance with the local development scheme. When adopted, this will form part of the Herefordshire Local Plan.
	2. Not to delegate authority to make necessary and minor amendments is not recommended because it would be impracticable to await a further meeting with the Cabinet Member to address such matters.
