Decision	That: a) The waste service charges are updated in line with full cost recovery as set out in Appendix 1;

	<ul> <li>c) a new chargeable service is introduced for bulky waste collections for commercial waste as set out in Appendix 1;</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>d) the operation of the parish freighter service is ceased; and</li> </ul>		
	e) authority is delegated to the Assistant Director for Regulatory, Environment and Waste to take all operational decisions for waste management including to approve future changes to charges across the waste management service.
