Purpose:	To receive information on proposed organisational changes to the local Health Service as a result of a DoH paper on "Commissioning a Patient-Led NHS" and to respond to the Strategic Health Authority (SHA) Consultation.
Decision:	THAT (a) Cabinet agrees to state the case strongly for the retention of a Herefordshire sovereign NHS body commissioning service for the Herefordshire public; and
	(b) Cabinet comments on a draft response to consultation by the Strategic health Authority on the implications for local services.
Reasons for the Decision:	On 27th July, 2005, the Department of Health published "Commissioning a Patient Led NHS" setting out a framework for improving commissioning of services alongside improvements in health and service delivery. The main factors in the guidance are:
	PCTs of the future will concentrate on commissioning and improving public health
	PCTs will not directly provide services (this may be allowed only in the most exceptional circumstances)
	GP practice-based commissioning will be fully developed
	 A reduction in the number of SHAs, Ambulance Trusts and PCTs
	Most NHS Trusts will become Foundation Trusts
	 An expectation that PCT boundaries will match those of Local Authorities
	Delivery of at least 15% reduction in management and administrative costs.
