

Consultation on services for families with young children in Herefordshire

Service providers questionnaire

Herefordshire Public Services are committed to ensuring that every child in Herefordshire is given the best start in life.

We know that the majority of our young children do well, but the gap between the children who do well and the ones that don't is increasing. We want to make sure that we make best use of the budget available to ensure we are supporting all children to achieve their potential.

Our commitment to ensuring this in Herefordshire is demonstrated in the four priorities of the "Yes We Can Plan 2011-14" which is the overarching county plan for children and young people:

- Helping families, parents and carers to help themselves, particularly in the early years of their children's lives;
- Promoting health and well-being;
- Achieving success in learning and future employment;
- Protecting children from harm.

Children centres are best placed in the county to meet these priorities by providing a wide range of support to families with young children. We would like to find out from families, professionals and communities on the types of services children's centres should be delivering in the future and explore whether there are other ways to provide these services.

The aim of this consultation is:

"To identify an affordable model for the delivery of Herefordshire children centre services that will help all children achieve their potential and takes full account of the changing national policy, the financial challenges the local authority faces and Herefordshire Council and NHS Herefordshire's desire to commission services based on the needs of families."

This consultation will enable us to understand what works well, what could work better and what we should be prioritising to ensure the families that need the most support receive it.
