<b>ITEM:</b>	<b>Contract extension for Halo Leisure NHS Health Check lifestyle delivery</b>

Date of Decision:	6 March 2017
Purpose:	To ensure continued delivery of weight management and physical activity programmes following NHS Health Check whilst enabling wider service design and reconfiguration of behaviour change programmes to increase prevention of avoidable ill health.
<b>Decision:</b>	Contract extension for Halo Leisure NHS Health Check lifestyle delivery
Reasons for the Decision:	To ensure continuation of the service with the least disruption and cost. NHS Health Check is a mandatory provision required of the local council under the Health and Social Care Act (2012). This delivery will contribute to achievement of public health outcomes associated with NHS Health Checks, obesity and sedentary behaviour. It was a positive decision to not progress a business case during 2016/17 due to the introduction of the national diabetes prevention programme to avoid potential duplication. We we are now in a position to scope and commission an integrated weight management service to target available resources to achieve the best outcomes.
