

Appendix A – Conditions

General

1. The premises licence holder shall surrender the current premises licence on grant of this licence.

Prevention of Crime

2. CCTV will be provided in the form of a recordable system, capable of providing pictures of EVIDENTIAL QUALITY in all lighting conditions particularly facial recognition. Cameras shall encompass all ingress and egress to the premises. Equipment MUST be maintained in good working order, be correctly time and date stamped, recordings MUST be kept in date order, numbered sequentially and kept for a period of 31 days and handed to Police on demand (provided that the police will allow reasonable time for the recording to be obtained in the event that the request for recordings is made at a time when the premises are closed. The Recording equipment and tapes/discs shall be kept in a secure environment under the control of the DPS or other responsible named

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individual. In the event of technical failure of the CCTV equipment the Premises Licence holder/DPS MUST report the failure to the Police on contact number 0300 333 3000 immediately.

- 3. The premises licence holder shall employ SIA registered Door Supervisors on a Friday and Saturday night and on a Sunday night preceding a Bank Holiday from midnight until the terminal hour shown on the licence or until the premises close whichever is the earlier.
- 4. The Premises Licence Holder shall maintain a register of Door Supervisors which will be kept on the premises showing the names and addresses of the Door Supervisors, their badge numbers and shall be signed by the Door Supervisors as they commence and conclude duty. The register shall be made available on demand for inspection by an 'authorised person' (as defined by Section 13 of the Licensing Act 2003) or the police or an authority Officer of the SIA.
- 5. An incident log must be kept at the premises, and made immediately available on request to an 'authorised person' (as defined by Section 13 of the Licensing Act 2003), an authorised Herefordshire Trading Standards Officer or the Police, which must record the following:
 - (a) all crimes reported to the venue
 - (b) all ejections of patrons
 - (c) any complaints received
 - (d) any incidents of disorder
 - (e) seizures of drugs or offensive weapons
 - (f) any faults in the CCTV system
 - (g) any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service
- 6. The Premises Licence Holder and staff will not permit alcohol to be consumed on the premises.

Prevention of Public Nuisance

- 7. Prominent, clear and legible signage (in not less than 32 font bold) shall be displayed at all exists to the premises requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises quietly.
- 8. The premises licence holder shall provide 2 additional refuge (litter) containers to be located outside the premises. Such containers shall be secured and shall be sighted at a location agreed with Herefordshire Council Highways Department or their agent. Prominent, clear and legible signage (in not less than 32 font bold) shall be displayed at all exists to the premises requesting the public to respect the area and ensure that litter is disposed of properly and in appropriate litter bins.
- 9. The Premises Licence holder will ensure that the area immediately outside the premises is checked for litter at least once every 30 minutes, during operating hours and that any litter found is disposed in refuge sacks or bins.
- 10. Noise or vibration shall not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance.



Public Safety

- 11. All staff shall wear clothing which identifies them as members of staff of the premises.
- 12. First aid

A HSE Compliant Industrial High Response First Aid Kit for 21-50 people shall be kept fully stocked at the premises and kept behind the bar. Such kit shall contain:

- 1 x Guidance Leaflet
- 60 x Washproof Plasters
- 6 x Eve Pads with Bandage
- 8 x Triangular Bandages
- 12 x Safety Pins
- 16 x Assorted Sterile Dressings
- 20 Moist Wipes
- 3 Pairs Disposable Gloves
- 13. Electrical & Gas Installations

All electrical wiring and distribution systems shall be tested at least once a year and signed off by a competent person whose name is shown within the Local Authority Building Control Part P Competent Persons Register (http://www.competentperson.co.uk/search.asp). The sign off certificate shall be produced to an 'authorised person' (as defined by Section 13 of the Licensing Act 2003) or Police on demand.

14. Any and all gas appliances (except cellar gas) used in the premises must be tested at least once a year and signed off by a competent person whose name appears within the current Gas Safety register (GSR). The sign off certificate shall be produced to an 'authorised person' (as defined by Section 13 of the Licensing Act 2003) or Police on demand.

Protection of Children From Harm

15. No adult entertainment or services or activities must take place at the premises (Adult Entertainment includes, but is not restricted to, such entertainment or services which would generally include topless bar staff, striptease, lap-table, or pole-dancing, performances involving feigned violence or horrific incidents, feigned or actual sexual acts or fetishism, or entertainment involving strong and offensive language).
