Decision made	<ul> <li>THAT:</li> <li>(a) subject to the consideration of any objections received a new traffic regulation order be implemented the effect of which will be to change the status of two of the five existing parking spaces opposite Prospect Place in St Martins Avenue to electric vehicle charging bays and alter the duration of stay for the two parking bays to give electrically charged vehicles sufficient time to take on a full charge. The new order will comprise:</li> <li>(b) The alteration of two 'standard' parking bays to parking bays dedicated part time for electric vehicle charging.</li> <li>(c) Change the waiting time for the two dedicated part time electric charging bays from Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm maximum stay of 30mins no return within 1hr, to Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm maximum stay of 30pm maximum stay of 4hrs no return within 4hrs.</li> <li>(d) Maintain the current status and maximum waiting time of the remaining three parking bays</li> </ul>
