Reasons for the Decision:	This ECO flexible eligibility scheme presents an opportunity for the council, in conjunction with its partners at Keep Herefordshire Warm to select eligible residents to receive support as part of the scheme.
	A published statement of intent by the council would show its commitment towards the scheme as well as towards wider corporate and strategic objectives.
Consultation:	The SOI has been developed by Marches Energy Agency in consultation with relevant council departments
Options Considered:	The council opts not to take part in the scheme
	If the council chooses not to take part, the council will not be able to select residents for energy efficiency measures (boilers, insulation etc.) and will instead have to rely on conventional ECO funding, which to date has proved inconsistent.
