	(a) having carefully considered all comments received, a Traffic Regulation Order be made the effect of which will introduce waiting restrictions on the roads as detailed below:
	Prohibition of waiting at any time:
	<u>B4214:</u>
	<ul> <li>i) On the north east side from a point 26 metres north of the centreline of its junction with the C1133 for a distance of 57 metres in a southerly then easterly direction.</li> </ul>
	ii) On the south west side from its junction with the C1133 for a distance of 80 metres in an easterly then southerly direction.
	<u>C1133:</u>
	i) On the south side from its junction with the B4214 for a distance of 7 metres in a westerly direction.
	Any previous TRO, or part TRO, relating to the above, shall be revoked on implementation of the above said provisions.
Reason for Decision (if a report was produced to support the Decision, refer to and attach the same)	The removal of parking on both sides of the B4214 between the Chase Inn and St. Mary's Church will result in sufficient room for large vehicles to pass through the village through the tight bends and improve forward visibility.
	The implementation of the proposed parking restrictions is required for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising
