Comments in support of Pizza Hut's premise licence application @ 85, HR2 7RG.

Dear Sir or Madam

We note Pizza Hut has made an application for a premise licence to enable them to operate between the hours of 23-00 & 05-00 Monday to Sunday in what was for many years a busy public house.

It should also be noted busy burger van's operated in front of this pub for some years catering late into the night without problem.

This business appears to have been managed responsibly to date respecting local authority regulation advertising & closing at 11pm in the absence of a premise licence with an adequately sized internal customer waiting area.

We support this application as we believe opposite the 24hr Asda superstore & garage whilst adjacent to the dual carriageway alongside other business premises is the right place for a late night pizza shop take away & delivery service to operate rather than overlooking a residential area.

Clearly granting this License may go some way to alleviating amenity problems for residents caused by a near identical operation (Domino's) sited overlooking an out of town residential area which appears intent on continuing to disregard LA regulation & in our opinion should never have been granted a 4am license that needs reviewing.
