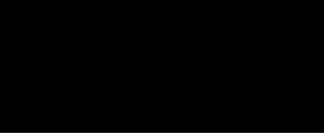

**Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions**

(1) Supply of alcohol

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-

- (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
- (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

**Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule****Licensing objectives**

General: None

**Prevention of Crime:**

CCTV must be installed at the premises which meets the requirements of the Police and Licensing Authority.

**Public Safety:**

External CCTV camera must be installed

Open bottles or containers must not be taken off the premises

The premises must be adequately ventilated whilst open to the general public.

All parts of the premises must be provided with adequate illumination whilst the premises are being used for any licensable activity. All routes of escape and all parts of the premises to which the public has access must be provided with adequate and assured lighting.

**Prevention of Public Nuisance:**

The licensee must ensure that noise and vibration does not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance.

Notices must be displayed requesting customers to leave quietly.

**Protection of Children**

Children cannot buy alcohol unless they can prove they are over 21 years of age.

Staff must ensure sight of evidence of age from any persons appearing to those engaged in selling or supplying alcohol to anyone under the age of eighteen and who is attempting to buy alcohol.

Staff must be trained and aware of the Proof of Age Regulations and Proof of Age Cards and/or Citizens Cards.

No person under the age of eighteen years old shall be allowed to serve alcohol within the premises without written permission of the Council.
