Reasons for decision:	The Colwall school project is ongoing and due to the loss of the existing Project manager a new Project manager was required to complete the project in accordance with the Contractual requirements of the NEC 3 form of contract being used and to ensure the successful completion of the project within the time frames and the cost envelope agreed. The contract was awarded after a tender process inviting 4 consultants to submit quotations. The pace partnership was adjudged to be the best value in terms of both cost and quality following this process.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:	The decision was discussed with finance but there were no apparent, major equality considerations that were apparent with this decision to appoint a project manager. The legal implications were not complying with the NEC contract which requires a named, suitably qualified and experienced Project manager, and the cost of delays through being unable to meet the terms of the contract. There are any health and safety implications and legal implications in not taking this decision as it would have meant the Council was not acting in accordance with the contract it has with Kiers construction and there was a risks, and of delays and cost penalties if this was done.
