Decision made:	under Section 91(1) of the Local Government Act 1972. In pursuance of the power conferred upon it by Section 91 of the Local Government Act 1972 the Council has appointed Ms TL Bowes of 113 Dorchester Way, Belmont, Hereford HR2 7ZW and Mr JF Johnson of The Old School, Kingstone, Hereford HR2 9ET and Mr SD Williams of Underoak, Grafton Lane, Hereford HR2 8BW to act as Members of Madley Parish Council until an election has been held and to fill such vacancy as shall constitute and re-establish a quorum in the Parish Council or after six months beginning from the date on which the Order is signed, whichever is the earlier, whereupon such appointments and this Order shall cease.		
Reasons for decision:	Following the resignation of a number of Parish Councillors, there were so many vacancies in the parish of Madley that the parish council is unable to act. By issuing the order to appoint three local ward members it brought the parish of Madley into quorum.
