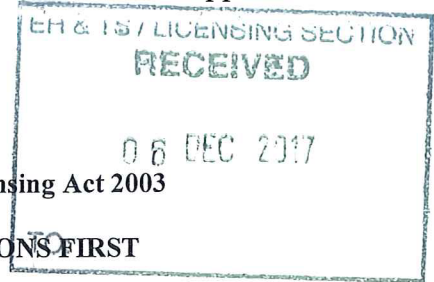

### **Application to vary a premises licence.....attachment letter**

Over the last five years we have been granted at least 50 Temporary Events Notices enabling us to open until 3.00am. We have not been informed of any disturbance, vandalism or noise nuisance caused by our customers from the Police or any other person in the vicinity.

To prevent Noise Nuisance, the bass on the amplifiers has been suppressed so that the volume is not travelling at a high frequency, therefore less sound is heard outside the building. The soundproofing has been upgraded, including the fire doors.

We have a very strict door policy and do not admit anyone who has had too much to drink or has an offensive attitude. We also have a smart dress code (no jogging bottoms). Any trouble makers are banned for 3 months, 6 months or 12 months. We keep photographs of banned people in our security and incident book. All bags and rucksacks are checked before entering the premises and then checked into the cloakroom.

We have security stewards keeping order inside and outside, making sure that people are not in the road. We have signage in place asking customers to have consideration for local residents and keep the noise down when leaving.

The music and disco lights are turned off at closing time. The main lights are turned up and customers have 20 minutes to drink up, talk to friends and chill in a calm atmosphere before leaving. The outside of the building is well lit and these lights are not turned off until everyone has vacated the area.

We have never allowed glasses or glass bottles to be taken outside, only plastic bottles of water.

We do not have a Happy Hour.

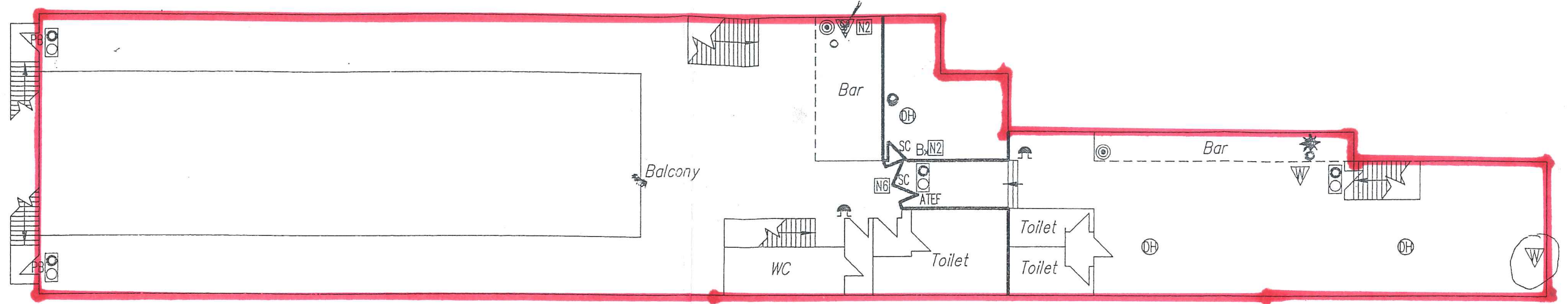
Anyone who looks under the age of 21 is asked for Photograph Id, ie passport or driving licence, which is checked by security.

This is a small venue operating since the 1950's. Admittance is limited to 300 customers and 80% of the customers are local and known to the proprietors and security firm.

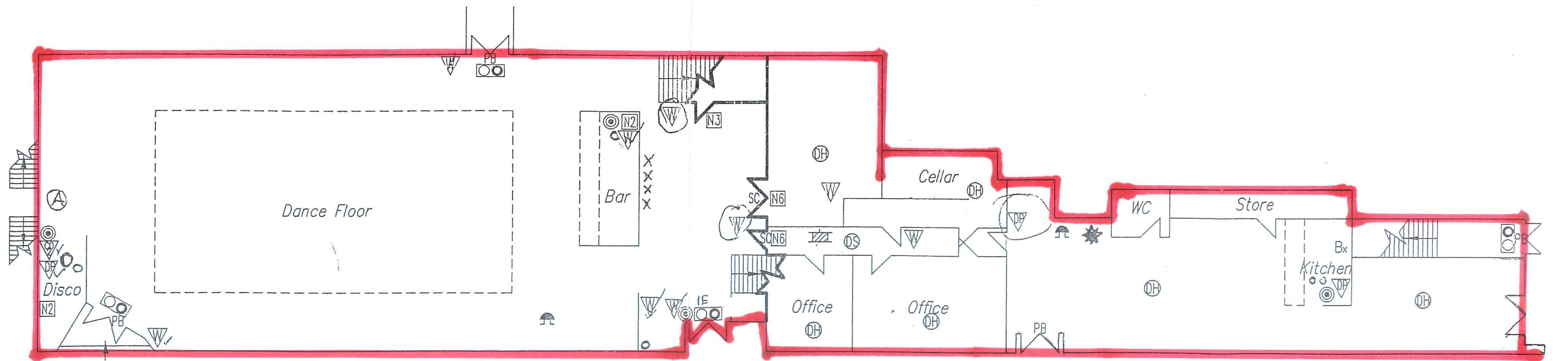
We are asking for an extension of one hour of opening on a Friday and Saturday night, so that we can compete with other venues in other towns.
