Civic Service - Sunday 18th March 2018 at 3.30pm

The Commonwealth Heads of Government summit meeting is to be held in London in April. As the annual summit meetings move round the various Commonwealth countries, it is probable that this will be the last such summit meeting to be presided over the Queen, following her decision to restrict her foreign travel commitments. In view of this, there is a move for Lord-Lieutenants throughout the country to put on special events to commemorate the occasion and for this to happen between Commonwealth Day on 12th March and the commencement of the Summit on the 16th April.

Following discussions between Her Majesty's Lord-Lieutenant for Herefordshire, the Dean and myself, it has been decided to have a joint Civic and Commonwealth Cathedral service on the afternoon of 18th March with a particular Commonwealth flavour.

Members are asked to note the date and to make a particular effort to help celebrate the occasion by attending the flag raising ceremony on Monday 12th March and the joint Cathedral Service on Sunday 18th March. Further details will be forthcoming in due course.

Weeping Window art installation

Working with the Cathedral and representatives from the WW1 Committee, the Council coordinated a successful bid which resulted in Hereford Cathedral being selected as one of the last 4 venues to host the famous poppy art installation – 'Weeping Window'. The installation, a cascade comprising several thousand handmade ceramic poppies, will be at the cathedral from 14th March to 29th April 2018. Alongside the display, will be an exciting programme of activities for visitors and the local community, to include a Home Front exhibition, talks, music, readings, school visits and family activities.

A project manager and volunteer coordinator have been recruited and they are working with a small organising group to secure sufficient funding to stage the event and to finalise all the practical requirements and arrangements.

This is a fantastic opportunity for Herefordshire, not only as a means of remembrance, but also for our local economy. Previous locations that have hosted the Weeping Window have reported a huge increase in visitor numbers (over 100%), increased take up of local visitor accommodation and increased spend.
