

## Q1 Do you support the continuation of the existing powers that makes it an offence when the person in charge of a dog fails to clean up its faeces?





## Q2 Do you support the continuation of the existing powers that makes it an offence to allow a dog into the following designated areas?










#### Q6 Are you a dog owner?


