Decision title:	Resident permit exception

Consultation:	<p>Cllr Poly Andrews (Ward member) is supportive of the decision but had some concerns around the limited parking availability in this area. Cllr Andrews wished that it was made clear the maximum number of vehicles permitted to park in this zone is not exceeded. Therefore the resident will be advised that they must not photocopy the permit and it can only be used on one of the two vehicles at any one time.</p>
Decision made:	<p>To give authority to the parking team at Hoople to record the registration numbers of two vehicles onto one resident permit rather than the usual practice of only one vehicle. This is an exception for one resident who resides within the Widemarsh ward. The resident permits are valid for up to 12 months from the date of purchase and if the resident moves address the exemption will not carry over the new resident.</p>
Reasons for decision:	<p>The resident parking scheme to which this decision relates allows residents to apply for one visitors permit and one vehicle specific permit.</p> <p>The decision is made with reference to the council's commitment to the Armed Force Covenant.</p> <p>There is no cost to the council, no loss of income and other residents will not be adversely affected as the number of vehicles parked will not exceed the maximum permitted for that zone.</p>
