Decision made:	 Credenhill Footpath Improvements: To add an additional Pedestrian Safety Improvements Scheme, with budget, as identified in the feasibility study. Works required are to widen a section of footway within Credenhill, by the pedestrian crossing and east Cottage, on the main road. Construction is planned for July/August 2018. S106 Whitehouse Drive, Kingstone: Following the development of a proposal for footpath improvements in Kingstone, draw down of 106 funds is required to support the scheme to be implemented within the village. The scheme is identified within the Annual Plan 2018/19 as a potential scheme, and has now been progressed. 				
Reasons for decision:	Cabinet member decision was given in March 2017 for the public realm annual plan 2017/18, with delegated authority for variation to annual plan to be taken by Officer. 1) Credenhill Footpath Improvements: To deliver a safer pedestrian route from the main housing development within Credenhill and the local Primary School. In order to accommodate a wider footway, a section of retaining wall and land purchase from "East Cottage" is required. Ground Investigation has been completed. 2) S106 Whitehouse Drive, Kingstone: To allow the design to progress with further stakeholder liaison undertaken to refine the aspirational proposals within the village to improve footpaths and enhance junction safety.
