	as the extent of the repair work and therefore the final cost will not be fully realised until intrusive investigation has taken place as part of the contract works. There are also temporary works (scaffolding), surveys and professional fees to account for so the decision is to proceed with a spend not to exceed £260k in total.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:	The final cost to carry out all the contract work and other expenses listed above may exceed the capped total spend of £260k and to mitigate this some non-essential work e.g. cleaning the façade may need to be omitted.

rejected:	Alternative option – do nothing. This has been discounted as the existing porch entrance is unsafe without the continued support of the scaffolding installed to protect the public, who use the building. Herefordshire Council continues to receive complaints from members of the public about the poor state of repair and the effect it is having on the building users and services such as Hereford City Council and the Coroner.
