Reasons for decision:	The Bromyard Development Plan Document will include policies and proposals to guide new development that will deliver both the strategic policies of the Core Strategy and more local detailed policies to guide development within the town. The preparation of the study will provide key evidence to help the preparation of Bromyard Development Plan Document with regards to the 5 hectare of employment land requirement indicated within the Core Strategy. The study will ascertain the requirement for employment land within the area and assess any potential sites, either within or surrounding the town, to meet this need.
	This evidence will be used to support the plan during its preparation included the public enquiry stage.

Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:	 a) To prepare the supporting evidence in-house. The preparation of a detailed employment land study will require a specialist knowledge and experience which is not available within the council. b) Not to produce the study. This would rely on the current requirement for 5 hectares of employment land as indicated within the Core Strategy. There has been some concerned expressed regarding the basis for this requirement and the ability to find suitable land for the allocation. The National
