

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The County of Herefordshire District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Brockhampton Parish Order, 2018.

Made 12 October, 2018

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

The County of Herefordshire District Council (“the council”), in accordance with [section 82\(a\)](#) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007(e) (“the 2007 Act”), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated *12 October 2018*:

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with [section 93 of the 2007 Act](#), has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections [86](#) and [240\(10\)](#) of the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the County of Herefordshire District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Brockhampton) Order 2018.
- (2) Subject to paragraph 3 below, this order comes into force on 1 April 2019.
- (3) Article 4 (which establishes the number of parish councillors for Brockhampton Parish Council) shall come in to force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2019

Interpretation

2. — In this Order—

‘ordinary day of election of councillors’ has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983; and
‘registration officer’ means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8(c) of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

Effect of Order

3. — This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 of the 2007 Act (agreements about incidental matters) relevant to any provision of this Order.

Number of parish councillors for the parish of Brockhampton.

4. —The number of parish councillors to be elected for the group parish of Brockhampton shall be ten. The number of seats on Brockhampton group parish be reduced from 15 to 10 to better reflect the number of electors; the ratio of parish council seats will be 5 for the Linton Parish group member (a reduction of 1 seat); 4 for the Norton parish group member (a reduction of 2 seats) and 1 for the Brockhampton parish group member (a reduction of 2 seats), and that the electoral arrangements will remain unchanged in all other respects.

Electoral register

5. —The registration officer for the county shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation to, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this order.

Order date

6. —1 April, 2019 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.
