Decision title:	To make a provisional Tree Preservation Order (TPO) at 30 Broomy Hill, Hereford
Date of decision:	8 th June 2018
Decision maker:	Service Manager, Built & Natural Environment
Authority for delegated decision:	ECC Scheme of Delegation and the functions scheme of the constitution: ' <i>Powers relating to the protection of important hedgerows and preservation of trees</i> '.
Ward:	Greyfriars
Consultation:	Consultation with the ward member.
Decision made:	To serve a provisional TPO.
Reasons for decision:	A section 211 notification was submitted to carry out work to trees within a conservation area. The notification came from the occupants on neighboring land rather than the tree owner. The trees are of high amenity value and it is considered expedient to create a TPO in order to be able to control any works.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:	The proposals have due regard to our public sector equality duty. There are no health and safety implications or other risks. This is because the owner of the trees is responsible for them, including monitoring their condition and undertaking any works required on safety grounds
Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:	Not to serve a TPO has been considered and is viewed unacceptable because the trees have amenity value and contribute to the character of the Broomy Hill conservation area.
