Decision made:	Award a contract to Severn Rivers Trust for the provision of services to assist with the delivery of the River Wye and Lugg NFM project, from October 2018 until 31 March 2021 at a total cost of £77,940.78.
Reasons for decision:	This contract will facilitate the delivery of the River Wye and Lugg NFM Project, which aims to reduce the risk of flooding to downstream communities.
	Severn Rivers Trust will provide a Catchment Advisor for the Brimfield catchment who will work closely with farmers and the community to help deliver NFM measures within the catchment. The Catchment Advisor will help bring in additional funding via the Countryside Stewardship Mid-Tier scheme. Severn Rivers Trust will also bring relevant expertise to the project which will help delivery.
	Herefordshire Council does not currently have an internal resource for the delivery of work packages 3A, 4 and 6. An exemption to contracts procedure rules standing orders form has therefore been signed for this decision (up to a value of £90,000) to contract Severn Rivers Trust to provide this service.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality	Financial
considerations:	The River Wye and Lugg Natural Flood Management project is one of 24 catchment scale projects funded by a £15m Defra allocation for natural flood management projects in England (funding secured until 31 March 2021). It is one of four catchment scale projects in the Environment Agency West Midlands area together

	with three community scale NFM projects. The project has a value of £626,000.
	By centrally organising engagement events and publications, cost savings will be achieved. Severn Rivers Trust will also bring in added value to the project through additional funding secured through the Countryside Stewardship Mid-Tier scheme.
