<b>ITEM:</b>	Preparation of a Temporary Road Closure Order made under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act (1847)
Officer Title:	Assistant Director Highways and Transport
Date of Decision:	23 October 2018
Purpose:	To authorise the making of a road closure order served under section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act (1847) to require the temporary closure of the following roads in Kington, <p style="text-align: center;">Church Street,  Church Road between Church Street and Hergest Road</p> planned to be effective for a period of up to 1 day commencing on 11th November 2018.
<b>Decision:</b>	Agree to complete all documentation as regards the said Order
Reasons for the Decision:	To enable the Kington Remembrance Parade to take place, for which purpose the Council, as highway authority, consider the closure of the road is required due to the likelihood of danger to highway users while the said event is taking place.
Consultation:	Not applicable
Options Considered:	Not to introduce a temporary closure of the road; but there would then be operational difficulties in the said event taking place, and/or would result in a longer period of disruption. In addition, there would be a greater risk to users of the highway and possible claims against the highway authority as a result
