Decision title:	Temporary resident parking permit concession
Date of decision:	7 th February 2019
Decision maker:	Parking Enforcement Manager
Authority for delegated decision:	Paragraph 27 of The Directorate scheme of delegation: updated 27/11/18.
Ward:	Central Ward
Consultation:	Consulted with the relevant ward member who was happy to support the proposal.
Decision made:	To allow a resident of East Street, Hereford to be able to apply and pay for a temporary 12 month vehicle specific resident permit for zone A – Hereford.
Reasons for decision:	The resident's property is situated near to a resident parking zone but not eligible to apply for a permit. Due to their child's temporary medical circumstances the resident requires frequent and quick access to their vehicle which the permit should allow. The resident will not be allowed to renew the permit once it expires unless there are continued and unexpected medical grounds.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:	<p>There is limited parking availability in resident parking zone A – Hereford so there is a risk that parking may not be available at all times. As this concession is only to allow parking for one additional vehicle the risk is low.</p> <p>There are any health and safety implications to the resident's child if the request for temporary parking was declined.</p>
Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:	Considered declining the request but the policy does allow exceptional circumstances to be considered. Due to the medical circumstances this consideration was rejected.
