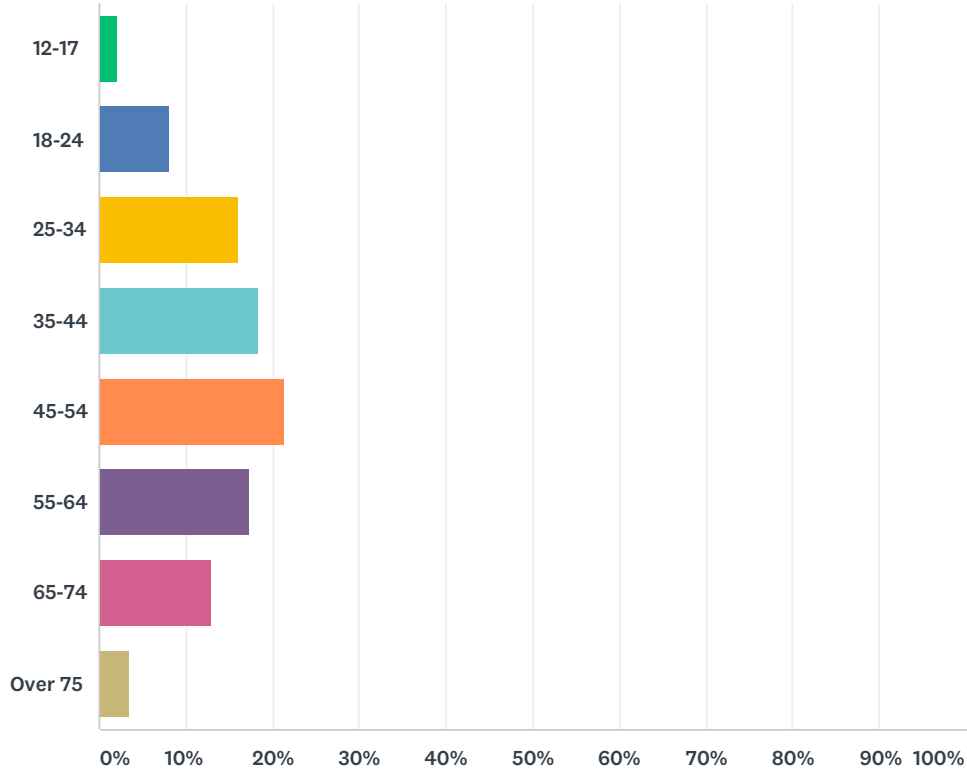


Q1 What is your age range?

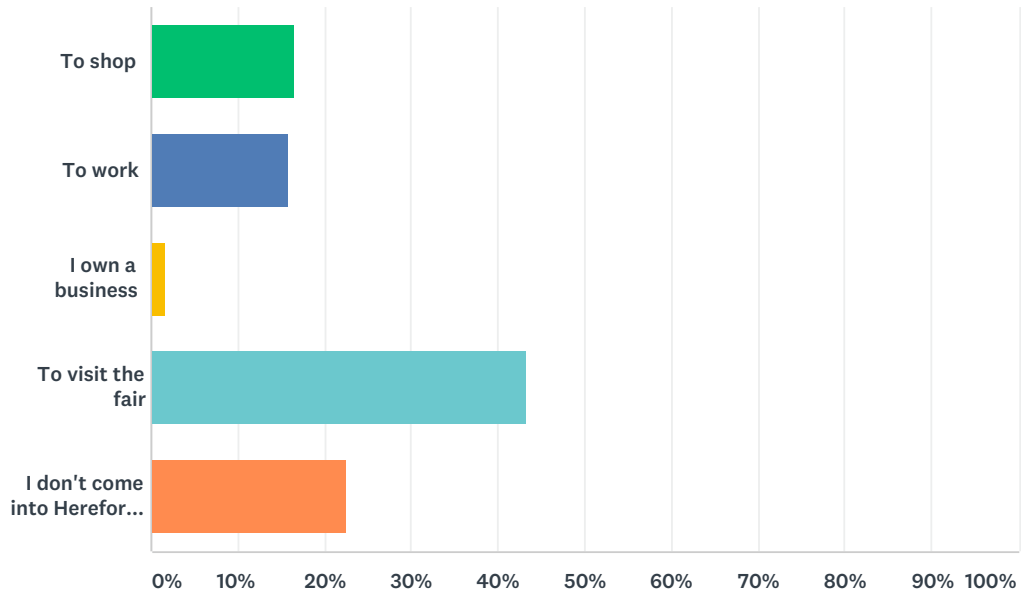

Q2 If you come into Hereford City during the May Fair, which best describes your reason for visiting?

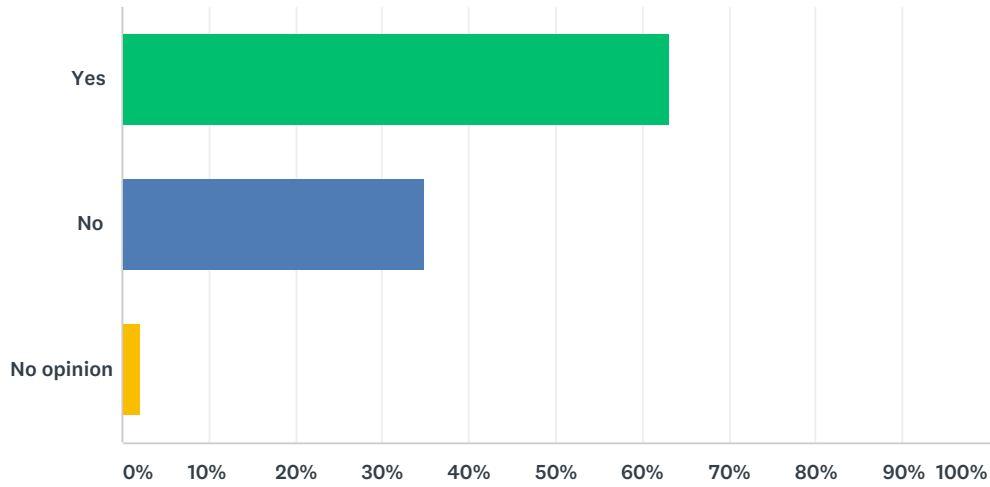

Q3 The traditional May Fair has been held in the streets of Hereford for hundreds of years, do you feel this is still the most appropriate place?

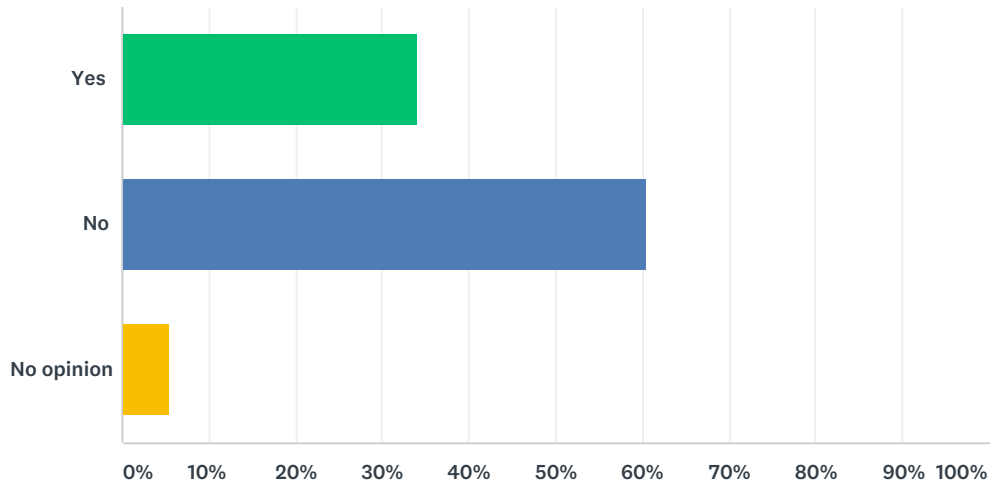

Q4 Do you think the May Fair should continue in Hereford but in a different place?

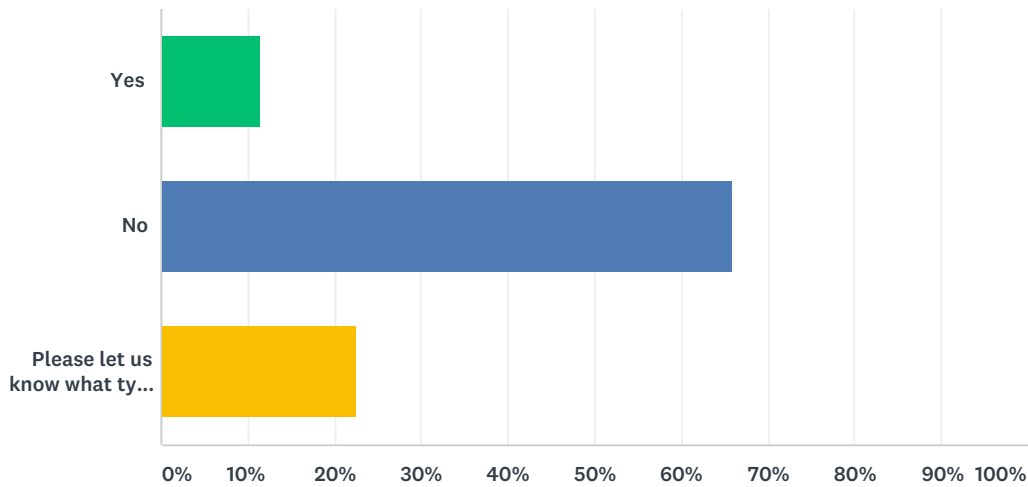

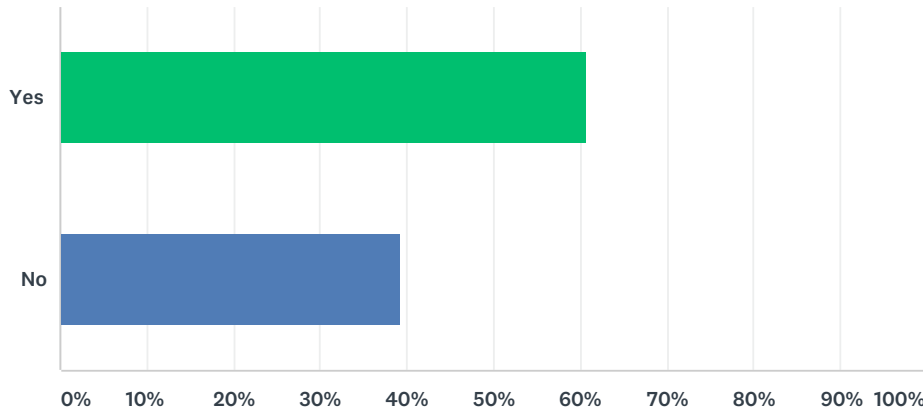

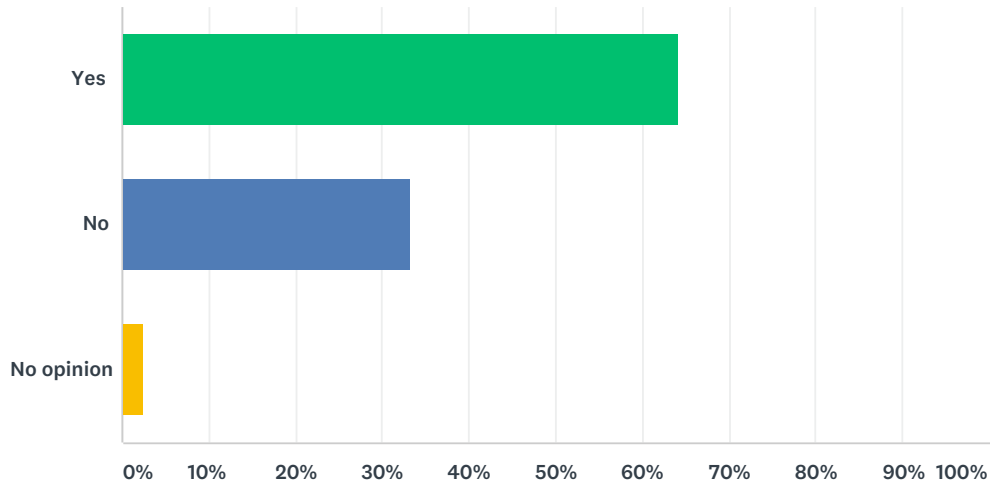
