**18<sup>th</sup> January 2019****Residents Parking – Geoffrey Avenue**

In October 2018 we wrote to residents to advise them of the outcome of the statutory consultation on the proposals for resident parking in College Ward. In that letter we noted that the decision in relation to Geoffrey Avenue and the north of Lingen Avenue had been deferred. This means that the proposals for these streets were neither withdrawn nor implemented; the decision on how to proceed was deferred to be taken at a later date.

The decision on the proposals was deferred because there was significant objection to the proposals from residents, but with restrictions being introduced in surrounding streets there was potential for parking to increase significantly in Geoffrey Avenue and the north of Lingen Avenue. By deferring the decision it has been possible for residents to experience the changes in parking following the introduction of the other restrictions in the area at the beginning of November 2018.

Herefordshire Council will need to make a decision on the proposals that have been deferred and to inform that decision we are undertaking this additional survey of residents in Geoffrey Avenue and the north of Lingen Avenue. We are asking if, following the introduction of resident parking restrictions in surrounding streets, you would now like the restrictions to be introduced or if you would like the proposals withdrawn.

We have enclosed the map showing the proposals that were consulted on previously. We would note that the decision can only be on the introduction or withdrawal of these proposals as advertised. It is not possible at this point to introduce different proposals. The proposals are for permit parking in Geoffrey Avenue and the north of Lingen Avenue with 2 hours limited waiting Monday – Saturday between 9:00am and 6:00pm. This means that residents / visitors can park without permits for 2 hours during the day, or from 4pm in the afternoon to 11am the following morning without needing a permit. Households may apply for up to 4 residents permits and one visitors permit. The permit charges are shown below and are subject to annual review:

- First and second permits - £30.00 each
- Third permit - £75.00
- Fourth and fifth permits - £100.00 each

To understand your views, please complete the attached survey and return it in the enclosed freepost envelope. Responses should be returned so they arrive with us no later than the 28<sup>th</sup> January 2019. These will then be reviewed and a report prepared for the Herefordshire Council decision maker who will decide if the proposals should be withdrawn or implemented. It is anticipated that the decision will be made in March 2019. If the decision is

taken to implement the proposals this would happen approximately two months following the decision.
