The authority are satisfied that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• the house licensed is reasonably suitable for occupation by not more than the maximum number of households or persons mentioned in the licence or can be made suitable</li> <li>• the licence holder is a fit and proper person and is the most appropriate person to be the licence holder</li> <li>• that the proposed manager of the house is a fit and proper person and is either the person having control of the house or a person who is an agent or employee of that person</li> <li>• the proposed management arrangements for the house are otherwise satisfactory.</li> </ul> <p>In making the decision, the authority has referred to the Housing Act 2004, associated regulations and Herefordshire Council's published HMO amenity guide and enforcement policy.</p>
