Elizabeth Malcolm Brampton Foy Parish Council	<p>The diagram provided on 6th March shows proposed double yellow lines on the bend around the oak tree, but omits the lines proposed in our response to you of 7th February beside the kitchen area of Oak House Nursery. The Parish Council feel that the extension of the lines to this area is important and should extend all the way to the end of the kitchen building.</p> <p>Additionally it is not clear from the documents if the signage and road markings at the junction are to be improved. Junction markings are almost invisible and signage is missing. The Council believe that action on these is vital.</p>
