- Monitors outcomes for children, performance and effectiveness by:
 - Setting and implementation performance management framework
 - Establishing data set
 - Establishing / implementing audit process
 - Case review findings
 - Voice of child
 - Meets quarterly

CHILDREN'S SAFEGUARDING PARTNERSHIP SUMMIT

- Partners
 - Relevant agencies
 - Service user reps
- Dissemination of local learning and best practice
 - Dissemination of local challenges
 - Identification of multi-agency working issues and potential resolution
 - Facilitates two way communication
 - Meets twice yearly/Termly?

DEVELOPMENT & PRACTICE GROUP

- Membership to be agreed
- Develop and oversee delivery of partnership training programme
 - Oversee amendments to policies and procedures to ensure consistency of practice
 - Develop and implement engagement strategy with children and young people
 - Meets quarterly

LEARNING FROM CASES GROUP

- Membership to be agreed
- Considers cases that raise concern
 - Commission and oversee reviews
 - Provides Quality & Effectiveness Group with review findings and action plans
 - Oversees implementation of action plans
 - Agrees publication and dissemination of learning
 - Frequency to be agreed

 - 16+
