Cabinet debated and approved a report on the 2019/20 Local Authority Schools Maintenance Programme on 17 January 2019. Consultation has already been done in respect of the overall programme with the Capital Strategy Consultative Group, comprising a number of headteachers and council officers, who agreed the programme as a constructive way forward for the use of the grant. Political groups were consulted on the programme and no
objections or comments were received.
Agreement to: • To approve the fire alarm replacement planned maintenance works at Weobley Primary School, to be undertaken via Balfour Beatty Living Places, at an initial cost of £21,591 plus associated contingency, professional and statutory fees. A total cost up to the value of £27,000
 Fund the works from the existing school capital maintenance budget
Weobley Primary was included in the approved schools planned maintenance programme 2019/20 for fire precaution works. The costs received lie within the original budget provided in the cabinet report of £40k plus fees.

Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:	The works can be covered within the budget originally allocated for fire precautions as part of the planned maintenance programme. There is a risk that once on site, further work is identified if the condition of the supporting infrastructures are found to be poor. A contingency has been allowed to cover unforeseen elements once the fire precaution works are commenced. Should this contingency be insufficient then a further officer decision will be required.
Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:	Do nothing. This is not recommended as the school is not fully protected in terms of fire precaution mechanisms. Not undertaking the works could result in a significant health & safety risk to the building and its occupants. Undertake a different set of fire precaution works. The works put forward are considered the most appropriate and necessary to ensure the safety of the building and its occupants.
