Decision made:	<p>To authorise the making of a Motor Race Order served under Section 12 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 (as amended) to require the temporary closure of the following road and footpath in Eastnor</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. C311 - Clenchers Mill Lane between the boundary with Gloucestershire at the Ford and Birchams Care Home. ii. EA4 – Eastnor Deer Park between the A438 and footpath EA9. <p>The order shall come into effect on 7th September 2019 and is planned to be in effect for 1 day.</p>
Reasons for decision:	To enable the Cheltenham Motor Club Special Stage Rally to take place, for which purpose the Council, as highway authority, consider the closure of the road and footpath is required due to the likelihood of danger to highway users while the said event is taking place.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:	Local disruption on highway and footpath network which will be managed by the event organiser and appropriate signage.
Details of any alternative options	Not to introduce a temporary closure of the road and footpath; but there would then be operational difficulties in the said event
