**B4214 BROMYARD TO TENBURY ROAD – PROPOSED 30MPH SPEED LIMIT
EXTENTION**

I write on behalf of Herefordshire Council and Balfour Beatty to advise you of forthcoming proposals to extend the 30mph speed limit section along the B4214 Bromyard to Tenbury Road northwards by 545 meters from its current termination point as shown on the accompanying plan.

The proposal comprises the revocation of the existing 30mph Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) and the introduction of a new TRO to encompass the existing 30mph limit and the proposed extension to the 30mph limit. The proposed extension will replace a section of National Speed Limit along the B4214.

A public notice detailing the proposals is due to be advertised in the local press. The scheme will not involve any physical site changes except for the relocation of the existing speed limit terminals.
