	Stoke Haven	No	No	No	-	Previous owners of the Old Rectory and Woodhouse between 1974 – 2006. Claimed route has been overgrown and obstructed by pig wire and wired up gates in the past so could not have been used continuously. Challenges user evidence and has witness who is of the view that the track is private. Understood footpaths SP2 and SP4 linked higher up to provide access to the Church and The Lamb Inn. Never given permission for anyone to use the path.
	Grovefields	Yes	No	No	-	Route has been used for 25years (the time they have lived in Stoke Prior). Strongly believes it is only a footpath and no higher status and should not be referred to as Grovefields Lane.
