I refer to the premises licence issued in respect of the above premises.

A premise licence is issued authorising the use of the premises for certain licensable activities, the times of operating and the conditions are to be complied with.

It is alleged that you held a live music performance on 25th May 2019 and the performance lasted beyond the times listed on your premises licence. It is also alleged that the level of noise from the band was causing a nuisance.

Please may I remind you that your premise licence allows the following and that all licensable activity timings and conditions must be complied with when the licence is in operation:

The times the licence authorises the carrying out of licensable activities

Plays / Films / Live Music / Recorded Music / Performances of Dance / Anything Similar to Regulated Entertainment

Monday - Sunday 10:00-24:00

<u>Late Night Refreshment</u> Monday – Sunday 23:00-24:00

<u>Sale/Supply of Alcohol</u> Monday-Sunday 12:00-24:00

Prevention of Public Nuisance

Noise or vibration shall not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance.

Under Section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003 it is an offence to carry on a licensable activity on or from any premises otherwise than under and in accordance with an authorisation (premises licence). This offence on summary conviction is punishable with six months imprisonment and/or an unlimited fine.

In line with this Authority's Policy, I must advise you that should you choose to operate outside your authorisation we may take enforcement action against you.
