ST KATHERINE'S BARN

I refer to the premises licence issued in respect of the above premises.

A premise licence is issued authorising the use of the premises for certain licensable activities, the times of operating and the conditions are to be complied with.

On Friday 21st June 2019, it is alleged that the level of noise from the band was causing a nuisance and that windows were left open.

Please may I remind you that conditions on your premises licence must be complied with when the licence is in operation?

Prevention of Public Nuisance

Noise or vibration shall not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance.

Windows (in the public areas) at the premises shall be kept closed after 23:00.

Under Section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003 it is an offence to carry on a licensable activity on or from any premises otherwise than under and in accordance with an authorisation (premises licence). This offence on summary conviction is punishable with six months imprisonment and/or an unlimited fine.

In line with this Authority's Policy, I must advise you that should you choose to operate outside your authorisation we **may** take enforcement action against you.
