Decision title:	Street Trading. Revocation of consent to trade at layby pitch on A49 northbound at Much Birch

Decision made:	To revoke a consent to operate from a trading unit in the layby on the A49 layby pitch northbound at Much Birch
Reasons for decision:	The trader concerned began trading at this pitch on 9 th October 2018. Various circumstances led to a lack of attendance at the site culminating in the trader being written to in March 2019 requesting pitch fee arrears be addressed and future intentions made known. After a short improvement in April and May 2019, the same scenario occurred again. No contact was made by the trader to explain and despite efforts made by the council to contact them, no response was received. Therefore the trader was written to on 8 th August 2019 signaling that the trading consent would be revoked on 22 nd August 2019. Nothing was heard from the trader and as such the consent was revoked.
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:	There are no associated risks as revocation is a power open to the council under the relevant legislation and under the council's street trading protocol.
Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:	To continue to allowing the existing street trading consent to remain live. This option was not deemed suitable as the trader concerned was not operating and would continue to accrue debt. It would also deprive others to apply for the trading pitch.
