| Decision made: | To confirm retention payment of the £20,667.73 to Collins Design and Build Ltd, the procured contractor for Skylon Place at Rotherwas, following successful sign off of the sustainability standard. |
| Reasons for decision: | The cabinet member for corporate strategy & finance approved total expenditure of £1.675m on the construction of 938sqm of commercial floor space spread across 3 units on plot S5 Hereford Enterprise Zone on 05.03.15. http://hc-modgov:9070/documents/d2922/Printed%20decision%20BUSINESS%20UNIT%20SCHEME%20ON%20PLOT%20S5%20OF%20THE%20ENTERPRISE%20ZONE.pdf? T=5 Following a competitive tendering process, Collins Design & Build Ltd were awarded the contract in the sum of £1,391,825.43. A Practical Completion Certificate was issued on 15.01.16, and the 3 units have been fully occupied since then. All new buildings on the Enterprise Zone have to meet specified sustainability credentials using a bespoke scheme designed for the EZ. The retention has been held pending the contractor meeting all these requirements. The Final Valuation Certificate has now been issued in the sum of £1,377,848.88 (a saving of £13,976.55 on the contract sum) and an invoice received for the outstanding retention in the sum of £20,667.73. The Purchase Order for this contract (740173) has been closed, with the balance on the order no longer available. The financial advice has confirmed that the Capital Interventions Phase 5 budget is the applicable budget to take the retention payment. Procurement's view is that the contract has been delivered and Collins Design and Build are now entitled to the retention payment. |
