<b>Decision title :</b>	<b>U70719, Sussex Avenue, Ross-On-Wye, Herefordshire Temporary Road Closure Order 2019</b>
<b>Date of decision:</b>	22 October 2019
<b>Decision maker:</b>	Engineering Manger
<b>Authority for delegated decision:</b>	Directorate scheme of delegation: updated 1 November 2018 Directorate: Economy and Place, section 69. To act on behalf of the council in respect of the legislation specified in the foregoing: Traffic Management Act 2004, Road Traffic Act 1988 Acting Assistant Director for Highways and Transport (Traffic Manager designate) and The Traffic Manager may in making arrangements to ensure that the authority has: (a) determined specific policies or objectives in relation to different roads or classes of road in their road network; (b) monitored the effectiveness of – 117
<b>Ward:</b>	Ross East
<b>Consultation:</b>	A communication plan will be implemented to inform and liaise with key stakeholders affected by this closure and the resting diversion. This will include local residents, businesses, parish councils and local ward members. Road plates will be on site to allow access for residents of those affected.
<b>Decision made:</b>	To authorise the making of a Temporary Road Closure Order served under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to require a temporary closure on the U70719, Sussex Avenue, Ross-On-Wye, outside Crossways, planned to be effective for a period of 3 days commencing on the 29th of November 2019.
<b>Reasons for decision:</b>	To enable Welsh Water to carry out service renewal works within the highway, for which purpose the Council, as highway authority, consider the closure of the road is required due to the likelihood of danger to highway users while the said works are being carried out. Nothing in this decision will render it unlawful to gain pedestrian access to any land or premises having a frontage to the said highway affected where there is no other suitable form of access.
<b>Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:</b>	Localised disruption on highway network which will be mitigated using diversion route signage and closure period to be kept at shortest possible duration.
<b>Details of any alternative options considered and rejected:</b>	Not to introduce a temporary closure of the road; but there would then be operational difficulties in the said works being carried out, and/or would result in a longer period of disruption. In addition, there would be a greater risk to users of the highway and possible claims against the highway authority as a result.
<b>Details of any declarations of interest made:</b>	None
