Consultation:	A communication plan will be implemented to inform and liaise with key stakeholders affected by this closure and the resting diversion. This will include local residents, businesses, Parish Councils and local ward members.				
Decision made:	To authorise the making of a Temporary Closure Order served under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to require a temporary closure of the roads shown in Article 1 Schedule 1 of the Order as attached. The Order shall come into effect on the 3 <sup>rd</sup> December, 2019 and is planned to be in effect for 2 days, with each road being closed for the planned duration shown in Article 1, attached.				
Reasons for decision:	To enable Welsh Water to carry out new service connection works, for which purpose the Council, as highway authority, consider the closure of the road is required due to the likelihood of danger to highway users while the said works are being carried out.  Nothing in this decision will render it unlawful to gain pedestrian access to any land or premises having a frontage to the said highway affected where there is no other suitable form of access.				
Highlight any associated risks/finance/legal/equality considerations:	Localised disruption on highway network which will be mitigated using diversion route signage and closure period to be kept at shortest possible duration. Pedestrian access to premises affected by the closure will be maintained.				
	Not to introduce a temporary closure of the road; but there would then be operational difficulties in the said works being carried out, and/or would result in a longer period of disruption. In addition, there would be a greater risk to users of the highway and possible claims against the highway authority as a result.
