Decision made:	To fund £9,035, including professional fees, for an external canopy to the reception class at St Thomas Cantilupe CE Primary School. Funding to be provided from primary Section 106 receipts from Nell Gwynne Inn, and school devolved capital.	
Reasons for decision:	Access to and egress from the reception classroom at St Thomas Cantilupe is via the dedicated play area for the class. Currently there is no protected cover outside this play area which doubles as a free-flow space for children to play during the day. The provision of a canopy has provided the weatherproofing needed for access and egress, to enable free-flow play and enable more children to benefit from the outside facilities and explore their outdoor environment all year round. The project was subject to a competitive tendering exercise with the contractor providing the most cost effective tender being recommended for appointment.
