Decision made:	That authorisation be given to implement the above recommendation in respect of the key decision dated 15 <sup>th</sup> June 2018 and re-allocate a sum not exceeding £45,000 from the underspend of the 2018/19 property estate enhancement works budget to carry out improvement works at the Edgar Street Football Stadium.
Reasons for decision:	The works include for provision of a new fall arrest system to all four lighting towers to enable safe access to the high level lighting and plant. A new lightning protection system is also to be installed.
