| Reasons for decision: | Morris, David Morris and Allison Appleton fairground operators. The Hereford May Fair was established in 1121 by royal charter and Leominster fair was referenced in a 1685 charter. It is recognised that these street fairs create a unique atmosphere and represent a part of the heritage of Hereford and Leominster attracting both local residents and visitors from further afield. |
