Decision made:	To issue a simple caution to the defendant for one offence under Environmental Protection Act 1990 Section 34
Reasons for decision:	Between 22 nd March and 12 th April 2019 the defendant was collecting scrap metal from various places. The defendant failed to transfer the waste to an authorised person and secure the transfer of a written description of the waste. During interview the defendant fully admitted the offence and indicated he has learnt from his errors.
